### Life in Fanwood


The first macadam road in New Jersey was built in 1875 and ran from Fanwood to Plainfield ... the Post Office was constructed ... the dam broke in Watchung and water ran through Fanwood as far as the railroad tracks and future mayor Horace Young went swimming on Martine Avenue ... the first school class was held in Fanwood Borough by Elizabeth Kyte in the library room of the Post Office ... a list of taxable dogs in Fanwood Township hung in the Post Office and showed three hundred in various shapes and sizes ... on Sunday the old Baptist Church stage coach drove around town to gather residents for church services ... the first arrest was made in new borough in 1896 ... the new Fanwood Fire Company responded to its first house fire ... the building of School One was the talk of the town; some residents felt it looked more like an asylum than a school.
