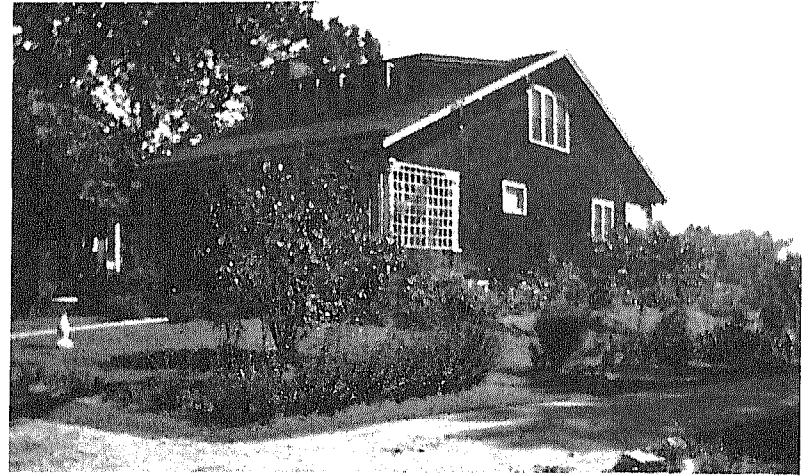


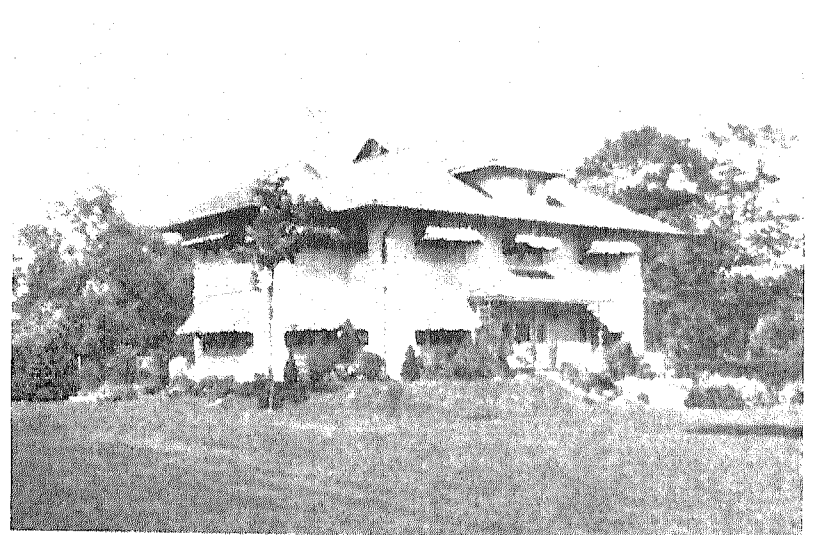
*Many of the homes along North Avenue were built by the Central New Jersey Land Improvement Company.*
