- Page 6 - 2nd par. -- The first Thomas Lee was known to be living in Elizabeth in 1674. His will of January 9, 1694, proved May 28, 1695, included lands in this area. The Thomas Lee, known to be connected with the house, was born in 1755 and was probably a grandson of the first Thomas Lee related to him through his son John. Susan Woodruff is also recorded as Susan W. Frazee.
- Page 6 - Last par. -- Thomas Lee, 2nd, should then be the 3rd; with his wife Susan F. Lee they had four (not three) children. A daughter Carrie died in infancy.
- Page 7 - Last par. -- History's dates tell us there must have been two Elizabeths known as "Aunt Betsy." One of Revolutionary fame who was born approximately 1705 and who died on July 23, 1792. She was the wife of Isaac Frazee and was said to be the grand-daughter of the first Thomas Lee. The second Elizabeth Frazee is mentioned in the will of her husband Gershom Frazee, Jr., who died in October of 1791. She is the Aunt Betsy who took in the infant Gershom Lee whose mother died shortly after childbirth. Gershom was the son of the 2nd Thomas Lee and his first wife Sarah Little, married on Dec. 8, 1782. Thomas' second wife was the mother of Samuel mentioned on the previous page.
