Translation

Felice Iaione 1915 - 1917

On the first of May, 1915, I was called up to the army. I was enlisted in the 93rd Infantry Regiment Omana. In the month of July, 1915, I transferred to the 121 Infantry Regiment Lona. For twenty-three months I was in trench warfare on the front lines on the Carso and on the Mte. St. Michael (Austria-Hungary).

In 1918, I was transferred as a police officer to the Legion di Mana. I was ordered to serve with the Campagnia Carabiniere di Ascoli Piceno.

I was honorably discharged from the service on December 21, 1918.

I was awarded a star, the croce di merito di guerra, given in Rome on November 12, 1919 in a formal ceremony for the following reasons:

In recognition as an important watcher in the front lines, resisting under heavy bombardment with calmness and serenity, remaining still in place; keeping a close watch on the enemy front lines while the bullets were exploding around him.

I was awarded a gold medal at the 50th anniversary of the victory. The honorary cross as a knight of the order of Vittorio Veneto.
