


**dow-ry.** . . . money or property brought by a

Montazzoli.

could be.

The original is preserved in a double-sided glass frame so that  
both sides can be viewed. It is one of the most precious items  
from the Iaione-Marcovecchio collection.

preserving this wonderful part of our family history.
