



A reproduction of a map of "The province of New Jersey divided into east and west, commonly called the Jerseys." This is from the second edition, "with considerable improvements," engraved and published by Wm. Faden, Charing Cross, December 1, 1778. The map was drawn from the survey made in 1769, and reproduced from the original in the collections of the New Jersey Historical Society, 1976. Scotch Plains appears as Scotsplain.
