



The Thirteen Star house. It was built approximately 1760, originally owned by John Ryno, and subsequently owned by Sea Captain Brown.



The DeCamp burial ground. Located on the corner of Lamberts Mill Road and Buttonwood Lane in Scotch Plains, this family cemetery contains gravestones dating back to 1782. The graves consist of Mr. John DeCamp (d. 1782); Deborah DeCamp (d. 1793), widow of John; Dr. Gideon DeCamp (d. 1815); Freelove DeCamp (d. 1784), daughter of John DeCamp and sister of Dr. Gideon DeCamp; and Sergeant Morris DeCamp, a Revolutionary War veteran serving with the Sheldon's Light Dragoons. The cemetery still exists today on private property, although it cannot be seen from the street.
