

The Scotch Plains Baptist Church at 333 Park Avenue in Scotch Plains. This is the third Baptist church erected on this site. It was built in 1870 at the cost of \$23,000. The first service was held in 1871. It is one of the few Victorian gothic churches built in Union County. The original structure is "110 feet in length and made of pressed brick with Ohio stone and white brick trimmings, . . . and transept corner tower and spire 120 feet in height." Notice the surrounding undeveloped property.
