The Fanwood Presbyterian Church, located at the corner of Martine and LeGrand Avenues in Fanwood. Construction for this building began in 1933. Previously, a survey had revealed that some Fanwood residents believed that they should have a church of their own. Services were held for a number of years in School Four until the church building was completed. By the time the first services were held in the new church, the congregation had grown to almost two hundred people. As the congregation grew, the building was modified by two additions.
