AROUND TOWN

If you were to take a walk through Fanwood, you would catch a glimpse of many of the first dwellings built in the town, including four early farmhouses, several Victorian beauties, stately Colonial Revivals, angular Craftsman homes, a street of cottages built to house some of the first railroad workers, and a neighborhood of homes built for Western Electric commuters. Some of the great homes of the past have been demolished, but photographs preserve their place in history. These early houses were the heartbeat of this residential community created by the railroad.
