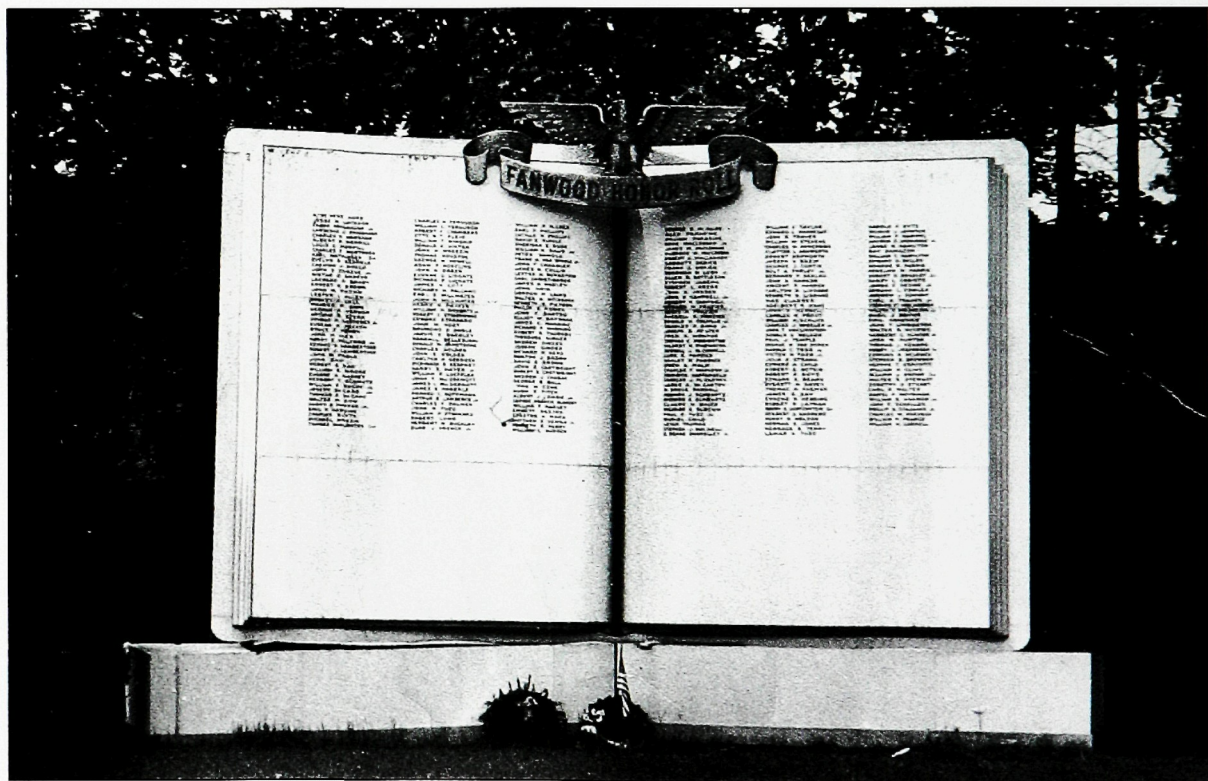


MARCHING. Fanwood's home guard, the Fanwood Militia, drills on the firehouse grounds during World War I.



THE HONORED. A 15-foot-high and 21-foot-wide honor roll, in the form of an open book, was erected on the south side of the Fanwood railroad station to salute residents of Fanwood. The names of 227 men and women appeared on the original roll, and gold stars marked the names of those lost in battle.
