

SCHOOL ONE. The first school building for Fanwood and Scotch Plains was designed by architect Stanford White. Located on Park Avenue in Scotch Plains, it was constructed in the 1890s and was said to be the talk of the town. Some residents felt it looked more like an asylum than a school. Nevertheless, children attended this school for many years. Sadly, in 1984, it was destroyed by fire.
