



THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL. Meetings of the governing body were held in the firehouse room in the 1950s. This was a time of expansion for the community, when facilities were needed for town officials. During that time, the borough acquired a parking area from a local resident at the back of the fire hall at a cost of \$3,500. An additional \$35,000 was designated for renovation of the building.
