TERMS CASH. The delivery of 1,000 pounds of nut coal to Anthony Farley was paid for in cash, according to this 1905 invoice. Note that the South Avenue address lacks a street number. Mail delivery to houses and businesses in Fanwood would not begin until the early 1930s.

ANTHONY FARLEY. His residence at 140 Farley Avenue was built just before the Civil War. He lived in the home until at least 1905, as the coal invoice attests.
