

Visiting Nurses Association of Plainfield and North Plainfield

Child Health Conferences are held the fourth Wednesday of the month in the Scotch Plains Rescue Squad Building under the direction of the Visiting Nurses Association of Plainfield and North Plainfield. This organization aids the physician with examination and immunization of infants and pre-school children. For an appointment to determine eligibility, call the association.

The Visiting Nurses provide nursing care in the homes of patients who are chronically ill, infirm, aged, or handicapped. All nursing care is given under a physician's direction. Services are paid for on a sliding scale with assistance from agencies such as the Cancer Society. Any resident needing nursing service may call this organization.

Westfield Day Care Center

Area pre-school and kindergarten children whose parents must work or whose home situations require day care are eligible to attend the Center. Fees are based upon ability to pay.

Youth Employment Service of Fanwood-Scotch Plains (YES)

Local adults volunteer their services to help area young people, fourteen years of age and older, find suitable work. The service is located in the High School on Westfield Road.
