School No. 1 has a cafeteria where hot lunches are available. The remainder of the schools do not provide lunches since the multi-purpose rooms (used for lunch rooms) are now filled with kindergarten children. These schools do, however, serve milk and provide supervision for those children who bring their lunch. All the school buildings have been constructed with auditoriums or multi-purpose rooms, and all the schools have playgrounds. For children interested in singing or playing instruments, there are grade school choruses and instrumental classes.

Special professional members of the staff include reading and speech therapists, school psychologists, guidance counsellors, librarians, physical education instructors, art and music specialists, as well as nurses, doctors and specialists in the field of special education (handicapped children).

The state requires that, upon request, transportation be provided for those elementary school pupils living farther than two miles from the school, and for those secondary pupils (9-12) beyond a two and one-half mile zone. The state pays 75% of the cost of transportation for the pupils.
