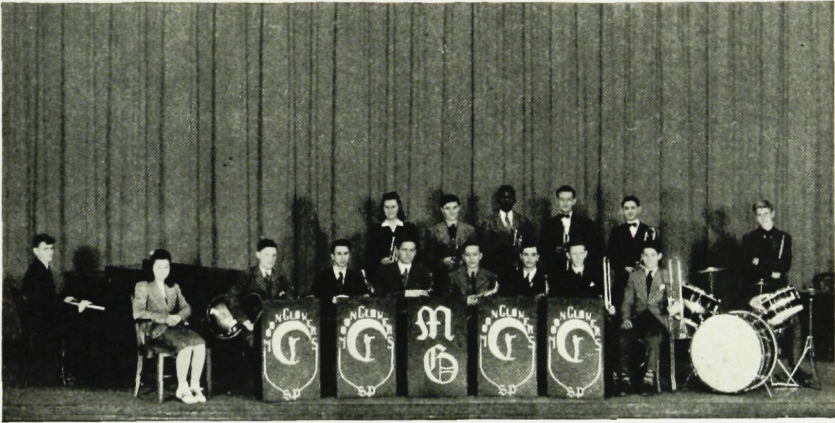


Forty - Two
