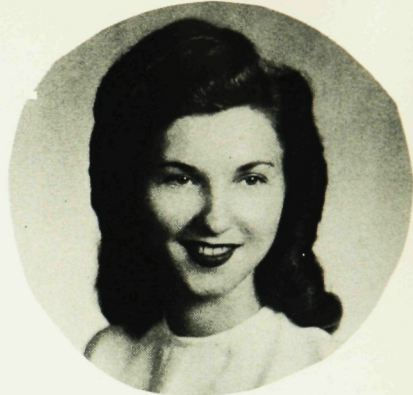


MARIE NANCY CHECCHIO
