

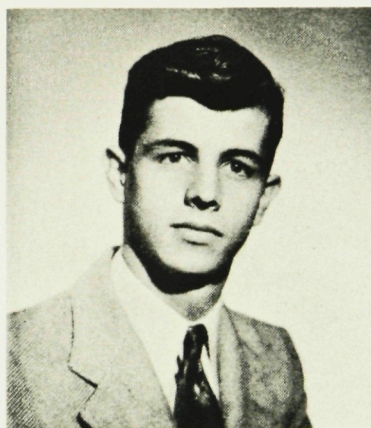
NORMAN CASSELL
