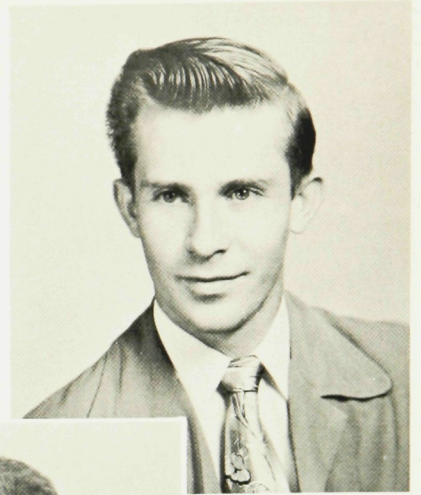


Robert John Leigh
