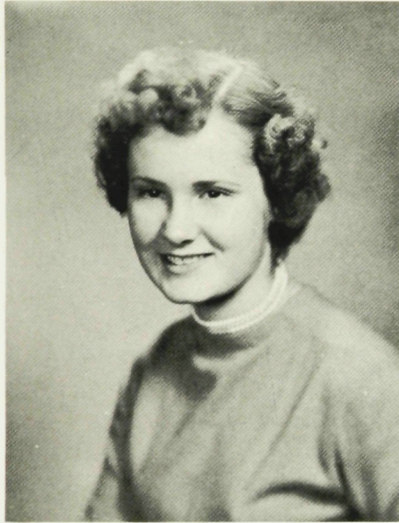
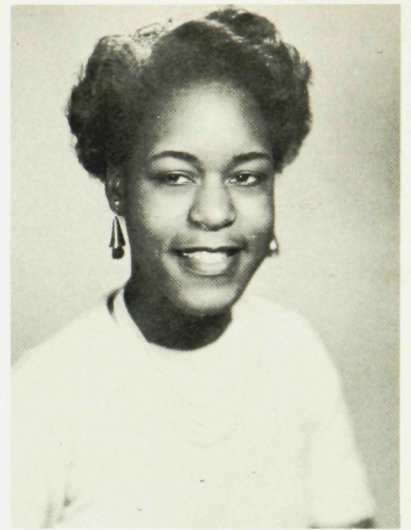


ANNA BELLE JONES

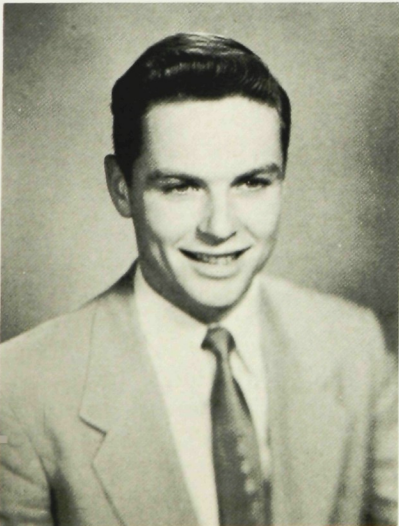
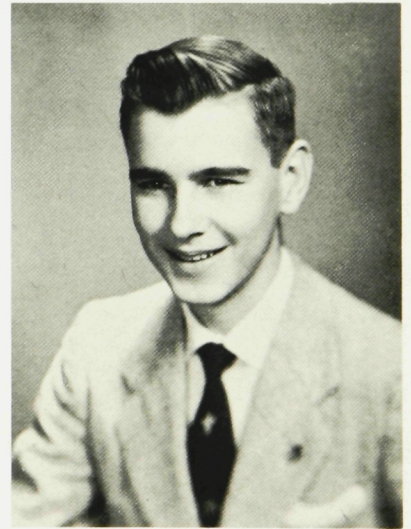
