Art; G. A. A.; Make-up committee; Dramatic Club.

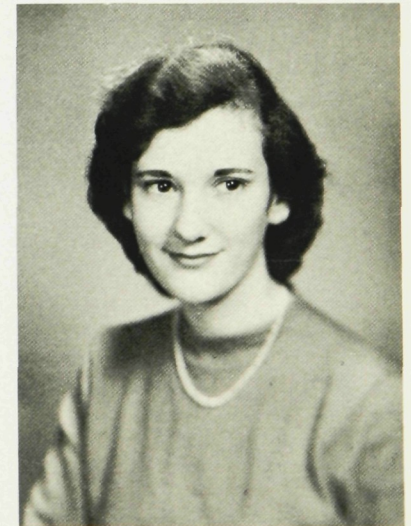
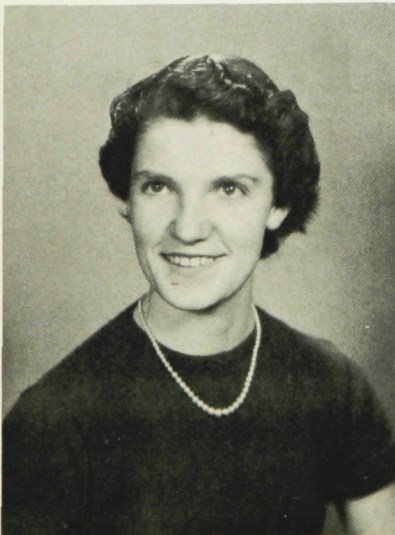
