

INDEPENDENT RESEARCH STRESSED BY ENGLISH DEPARTMENT

Important changes in curriculum and teaching methods were inaugurated in this year's English department. Sophomore classes are now studying English literature, which previously was the senior English course. The new senior English course, World Literature, was begun in several classes this year and will be available for all seniors next year.

Team teaching was practiced in larger scale in order to provide a greater variety of experience and a greater depth of study in relation to individual abilities and needs. This method was found to have a great advantage for the presentation of films, lectures, reports and discussions. An arrangement of this type allowed the students involved to get extra help, research reports, prepare a dramatization from a play currently being studied, or work individually on a topic of their own choice simultaneously, thus permitting each student to reach his own individual potential.
