




SCIENCE DEPARTMENT EXPANDS TO MEET THE CHALLENGES OF THE FUTURE

Scotch Plains - Fanwood High School has always placed an emphasis on a comprehensive science program which enables students with a diversity of interests to seek out their own curiosities. With the opening of the new addition to the high school, the Science Department was able to expand its previously crowded facilities. Three new biology laboratories were constructed to bring the present total to five. In addition, two physiology labs were constructed for use by Biology II students. Chemistry facilities were expanded to include three chemistry laboratories. A second physics laboratory was also made available to students at SPFHS this year.

Stressing the experimental approach to science, the Science Department offered contemporary courses which permitted the student to re-enact the great scientific experiments of past centuries. Aside from the excellent courses in biology, chemistry and physics, the Science Department also offered a course in laboratory procedures. This course was designed to familiarize the student interested in laboratory work as a vocation with the many techniques of quality control involved in industrial science.
