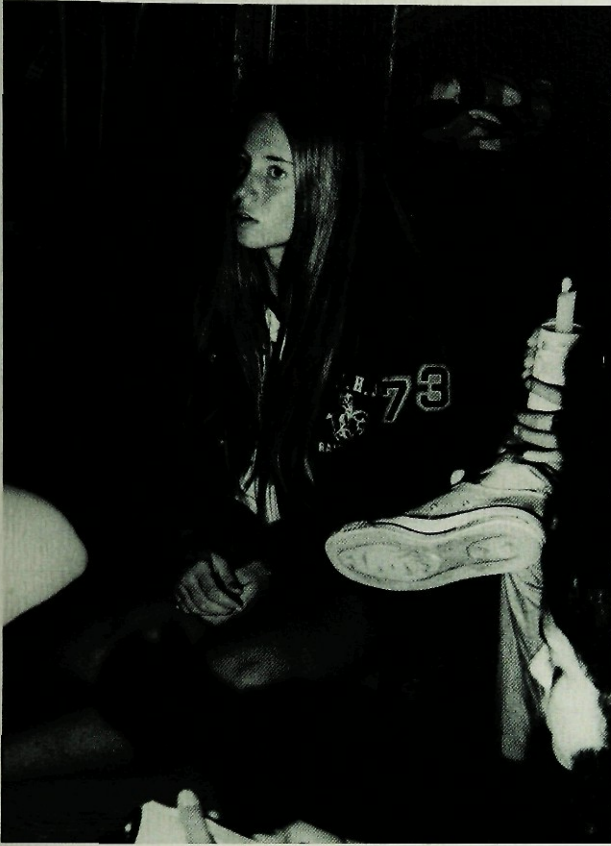


Student Leadership Conference
