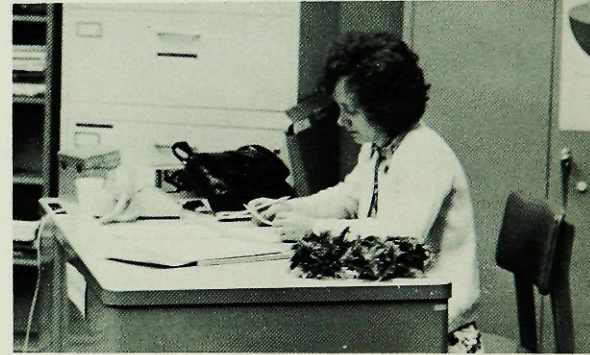


FOREIGN LANGUAGE DEPARTMENT

The ability to speak in a second language proves to be a meaningful and valuable experience for all students. Each year, the Foreign Language Department strives to have students gain an understanding of a foreign language. The department's curriculum offers courses in Spanish, French, German, Russian and Latin. This year, a Conversational Italian course was introduced. Tapes, filmstrips, games, and magazines were made available to students in the Foreign Language Independent Study Area. In an effort to enroll interested students in semester courses rather than the usual full year course, classes such as Current Hispanic Affairs and Black Writers in French Literature were offered. Language students elected a course in teaching elementary school children and received credit for it. In the Spring, students visited countries in Europe. Through a wide variety of course offerings the Foreign Language Department endeavors to enroll all students in a language program.
