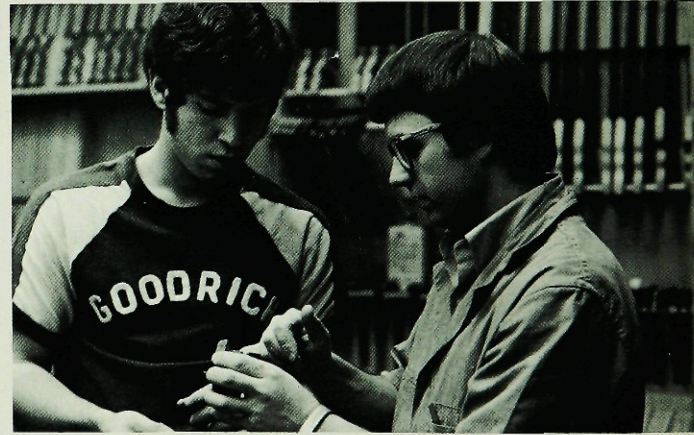
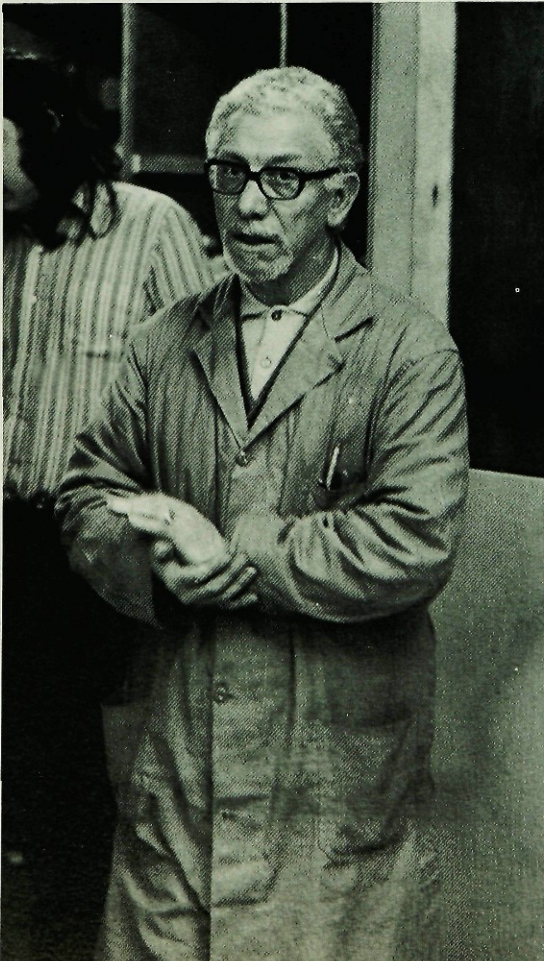

## INDUSTRIAL ARTS DEPARTMENT
