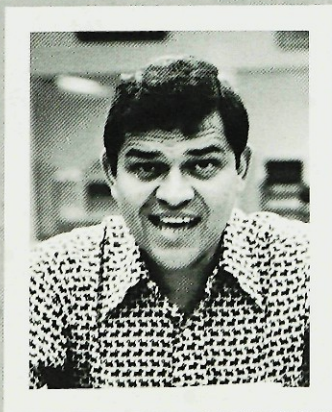


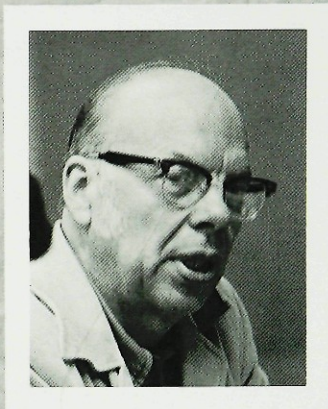
# SOCIAL STUDIES DEPARTMENT

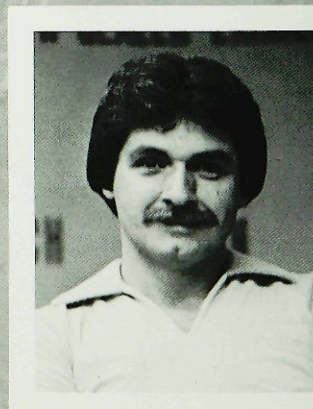
