The N.J. 821st Air Force Jr. ROTC is an organization designed to help high school students learn about aerospace science and to familiarize them with the opportunities available in the aerospace industry. The AFJRROTC teaches the principles of leadership which include respect for one's self, one's community, one's flag, and one's country. In addition, students are taught about the Air Force, the Air Force community, its mission and the Air Force way of life.

The one hundred and eighteen cadets involved with the program have participated in events at the high school such as college night and back to school night.
