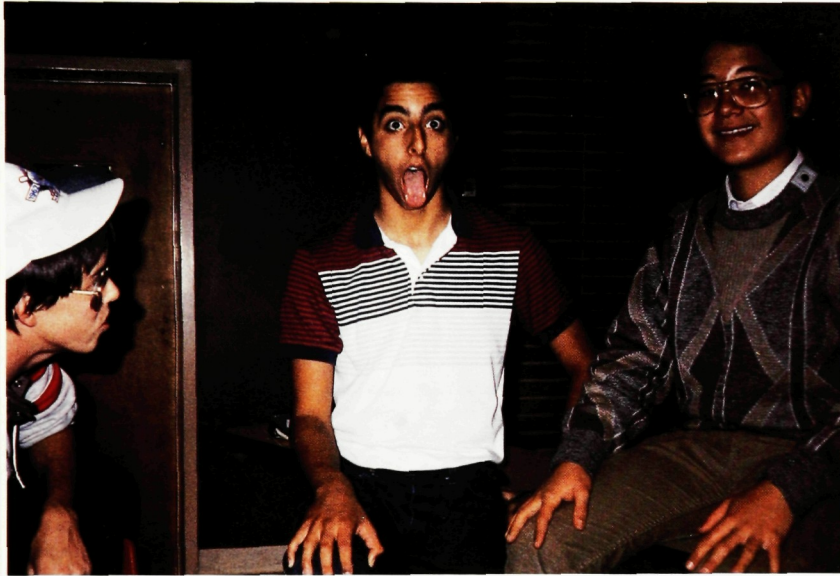


WANT TO KNOW . . . ARE THEY?
