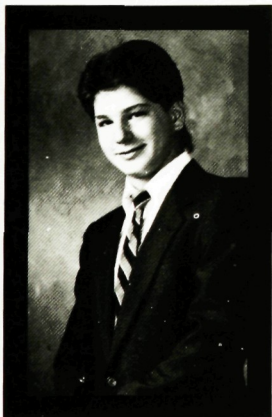


OF SENIORS IS ACCOMPLI JUNE 8
