B.1. OFFENSES Violations of school rules for which Procedure IA will be adopted will include

the following: Open defiance of authority of any teacher or person having authority.

- b. Use of profamity or obscene language
- c. Incitement which is intended to and does result in truency by other students.
- d. Willful and repeated tardiness to class.
- e. Corduct of such character as to result in the disruption of classroom instruction.
- f. Excessive physical displays of affection by couples anywhere on school
- property. g. Card playing at any time or carrying on-school parathernalia such as
- radios, tape recorders, etc. h. Loitering in school corridors or campus area.
- i. Wearing of headgear. j. Partaking of food outside of enting areas.

2. SERIOLS OFFENSES

Violations of school rules for which Procedure IA will start at Step 3 shall be:

- a. Stoking is prohibited anywhere on school property on regular school days between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Smoking is considered a serious offense and is defined as holding a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or any smoking device and/or exhaling smoke.
- b. Interference in any way with a member of the faculty who is attempting to discipline another student.
- c. Leaving school building or grounds without permission. d. Failure to properly identify him/herself upon request.
- e. Falsifying or forging any documents related to school.
- f. Use of profamity or obscene language when directed at a staff member.

3. MAITR OFFENSES

Conduct which shall constitute cause for an out-of-school suspension for a minimum of three full school days (on first offense) and further suspension and/or expulsion for repeated offenses, as well as appropriate legal action, in accordance with state law 18A: 37-2 and other applicable laws or administrative code, include the following:

- d. Taking, or attempting to take, personal property or money from another student by means of force or fear.

- f. Participation, by any group of students, in an unauthorized occupancy in any part of the school, a failure to leave after h ving been directed to do so b the principal or lesignee.
