

### B.1. OFFENSES

Violations of school rules for which Procedure 1A will be adopted will include the following:

- Open defiance of authority of any teacher or person having authority.
- Use of profanity or obscene language.
- Incitement which is intended and does result in truancy by other students.
- Willful and repeated tardiness to class.
- Conduct of such character as to result in the disruption of classroom instruction.
- Excessive physical displays of affection by couples anywhere on school property.
- Card playing at any time or carrying on-school paraphernalia such as radios, tape recorders, etc.
- Loitering in school corridors or campus area.
- Wearing of hoodies.
- Partaking of food outside of eating areas.

### 2. SERIOUS OFFENSES

Violations of school rules for which Procedure 1A will start at Step 3 shall be:

- Smoking is prohibited anywhere on school property on regular school days between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Smoking is considered a serious offense and is defined as holding a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or any smoking device and/or exhaling smoke.
- Interference in any way with a member of the faculty who is attempting to discipline another student.
- Leaving school building or grounds without permission.
- Failure to properly identify himself upon request.
- Falsifying or forging any documents related to school.
- Use of profanity or obscene language when directed at a staff member.

### 3. MAJOR OFFENSES

Conduct which shall constitute cause for an out-of-school suspension for a minimum of three full school days (on first offense) and further suspension and/or expulsion for repeated offenses, as well as appropriate legal action, in accordance with state law 19A: 39-2 and other applicable laws or administrative code, include the following:

- Continued and willful defiance of authority.
- Conduct of such character as to constitute a continuing danger to the physical well-being of other students.
- Physical assault upon another student or upon any teacher or other school employee.
- Taking, or attempting to take, personal property or money from another student by means of force or fear.
- Willfully causing or attempting to cause damage to school property.
- Participation, by any group of students, in an unauthorized occupancy in any part of the school, or failure to leave after having been directed to do so by the principal or his designee.
- Incident which is intended and does result in unauthorized occupation of any part of the school building or grounds by a group of students or use of any part of the school building or grounds for the sale of alcoholic beverages.
- Conduct of such character as to constitute a continuing danger to the physical well-being of other students.
