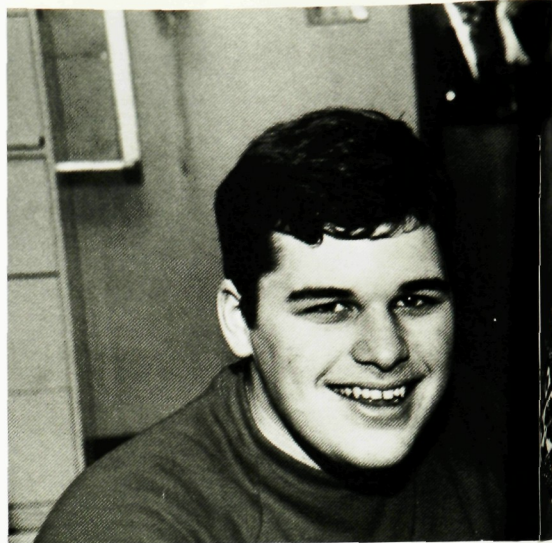

WHAT IS SO SPECIAL ED?

Special Ed is a program intended to meet both the academic AND social development needs of a student. It provides support and counsel for emotionally-disturbed students attending regular classes and Union County Vo-Tech classes. In addition, students identified as having any serious learning disability may be referred to this program by either guidance counselors or classroom teachers. Counseling gives these students a much-needed opportunity to voice their feelings and anxieties about school and life if they are to have a fair chance to succeed in academic and social areas at SPFHS, and beyond. Physically handicapped students may also find the teachers of the Special Ed Department important in coping with individual disabilities and the feelings about them which may develop.
