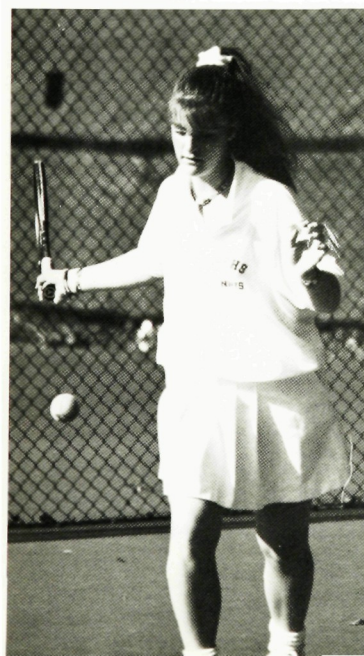
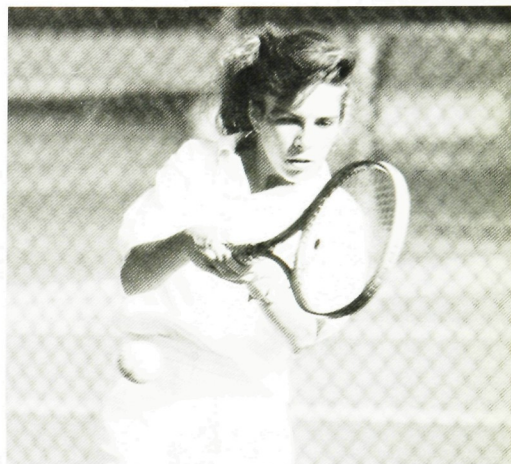


THEY'RE GAME, MATCHED, AND SET!

The 1989 Girls Varsity Tennis Team compiled an 11-5 season record, identical to that of last year. Singles play was dominated by Team Captain senior Wendy Shumway, junior Amy Snyder — with the best team

won-loss record — and sophomore Heather Tirsbier, a doubles player last season. Doubles play, the strong point of both girls' and boys' teams at SPFHS, was handled effectively seniors Brigitte Gard and Alexis Fertig, junior Michelle Ochs, and sophomore Carolyn Thierbach. Only 3 starting players will be lost to

graduation in June, but that will require constructing a new second doubles team and auditioning a new third seed singles player. Likely candidates for the latter position may come from a list including Michelle, Carolyn, Ilana Cohen, Stephanie Geiser, or Caroline Barna. All but Carolyn will be seniors in 1990-91.
