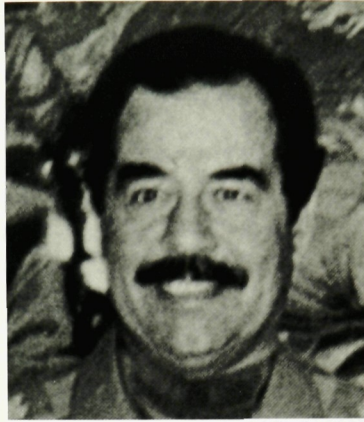


The Inside Story

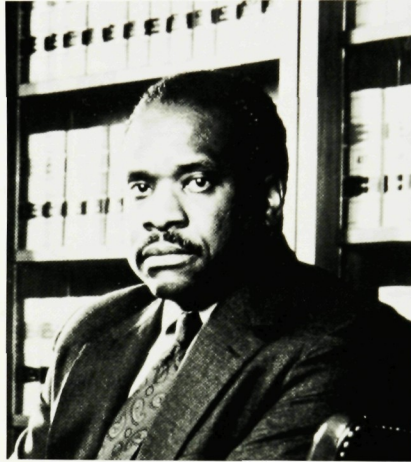
