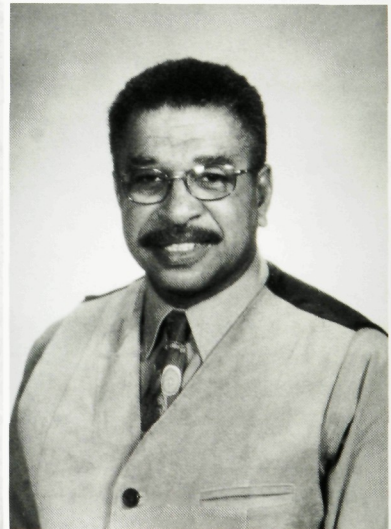
Dr. David Heisey
