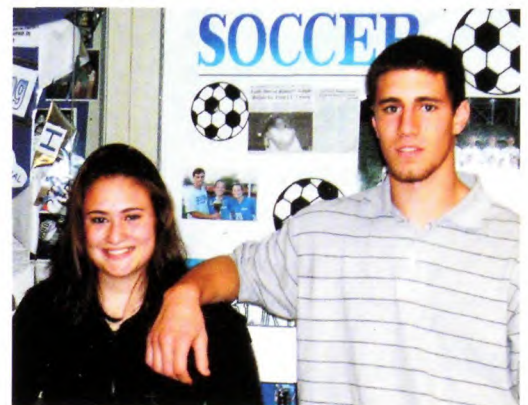
"Last year, when [freshman] Sam wasn't around, I did whatever I wanted. But this year, I have to be a good older sister so he can do well."
